Coaches Guidelines & information (Paul Huyser)

- Only one practices per week prior to the first game. Once games start, a 20 minute practice prior to the game is requested.
- Practice can only be outside. Do not reserve a gym through Community Ed.
- Practice starts Monday, March 31st (Due to weather and lack of volunteers Fields may not be ready by than)
- First game is the week of April 14th.
- Please try to keep substitution breaks to a minimum. (Half time is between 5-10 minutes)
- Remember before anyone plays four quarters everyone else should play three quarters first.
- Players should stay near their coach for substitution purposes.
Let parents know that if their child does not stay near the team they may be overlooked for their playing time.
- The home team will supply the game ball.
- Division Specifications- Only one adult (coach/Assist) from each team is allowed on the field.
- No jewelry- no exception.
- Ask Spectators to stay off the fields and from behind the goals.
- Remind parents/other to be respectful to referees, coaches and players. Cheer for the kids **ALL OF THEM!!!**
- All players must wear shin guards at practice and games including appropriate shoes. Socks must cover shin guards.
- Inter-play schedule: **Please contact the coach of the team your playing early in the week to ensure everyone is on the same page.**
- Privacy Act-Protect your roster. The information on your rosters is privileged and **must not** be given out to anyone for any reason.
