



Player Evaluation Guidelines

A.Y.S.O. Middleville Region 277

One of our goals as Region 277 is to provide all coaches with balanced teams to start the season with. As coaches, I'm sure that you appreciate receiving a team roster that is equal to others. If you have ever felt frustrated about getting waxed by a "stacked" team, or that your team did not have as many equally skilled players as other teams in our Region...Then here is your chance to make a difference.

- Please take the time to carefully and thoughtfully evaluate your current players. Be honest in your evaluation of each player's skill, knowledge, and abilities. It is critical that this information is accurate. These evaluations provide the primary information that is used to create next season's team rosters. The results of these evaluations are fed into an A.Y.S.O. computer program, which processes and spits out rosters.

Please write in the player's name and ID number on evaluation form. This help with putting the information into the program.

So, it is very important that the evaluations are consistent from one coach to another. Please keep the following in mind when evaluating your team.

- Don't evaluate the rest of your team against your best player.
- Do evaluate your team against the best players you have seen in your division.
- Do evaluate your players in practice and game situation.

You will be using a scale of 3, 4 and 5 in your evaluations.

Please use this guideline. Keep in mind that as players move up a division, they will be playing against older and more experienced kids. Rate them as follows:

3 - Developing.

4 - Average ability.

5 - Can do better than most.

Thank you for taking the time to evaluate your team. With this information, we will continue to improve our ability to provide truly Balanced Teams to you and the other coaches.
